US LIFTS COVID-19 TEST REQUIREMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL
June 10th, 2022

Dear Travel Partners –

On June 10th, 2022, the Biden Administration in alignment with new CDC guidelines announced pre-departure COVID-19 testing requirements will be lifted for international travelers to the United States. Effective Sunday, June 12 at midnight, those traveling to the U.S. will no longer need a negative COVID-19 test one day before their flight to the country.

Officials confirmed that the CDC will do a reassessment of the rule in 90 days and then on an ongoing basis to ensure the safety of international travelers. We will continue monitoring the news for changes and keep you updated as more details are announced around this measure.

We are encouraged by the announcement as it will continue to provide a frictionless travel experience for visitors to La Paz and we expect it will help revitalize the travel industry worldwide; however, we would like to remind all travelers that COVID-19 measures are still in place throughout La Paz and the use of face coverings is still required for indoor spaces.

The safety and security of travelers is our top priority. As a leading travel destination, we anticipate La Paz will continue to see strong tourism through the summer months and it is likely to be strengthened by this news. We thank you for your continued partnership to ensure all health and safety protocols are properly implemented.
